PROGRAM MEETINGS (MANDATORY)

November 4, 2:00-4:00 pm **2019 Kickoff & Parent Meeting** **First UMC, Sanctuary**

This is our first gathering of the whole group for 2019, plus a parent information session. We'll be talking about the year to come, taking care of logistics, talking about details our preparation, and getting to know the team. All youth, parents and group leaders should be there!
